



## **Wellbeing Zone Wishing Well**

Peer2Pier aims to involve students in the Wellbeing Zone through volunteering and running their own campaigns. In order to make this as accessible as possible, a Wishing Well fund is available to which students can bid for up to £250 per project. The mission of UBSU is “empowering students” and this is exactly what the Wishing Well is designed to achieve.

### **Application process**

Students will complete an application form together with a budget for their proposed campaign or project and submit this to the Peer2Pier Project Facilitator.

Decisions about the bids will be made by the Vice President Wellbeing and the Peer2Pier Project Facilitator in accordance with the criteria (see below) that have been agreed by the Wellbeing Zone committee.

### **Proposed Criteria for Wishing Well Campaigns or Projects**

The campaign or project must be:

1. **by** students **for** students (student-led; targeting the Brighton Uni student community)
2. not for profit
3. linked to at least 1 Wellbeing Zone Objective<sup>1</sup>
4. of benefit to a minimum of 10 students
5. planned using the campaign planning tool
6. delivered in partnership with relevant Union Societies where mutually beneficial
7. evaluated and a brief report produced for Wellbeing Zone committee

### **Publicity**

The Wishing Well will be publicised through **posters** and on the **Union Website** where an application form will be available to download.

Where appropriate students who raise wellbeing issues at **Student Experience forums** will be encouraged to consider how they could develop and campaign through Peer2Pier to address them.

**Convenors** can direct students they come into contact with to the Wishing Well, as appropriate, and also access the Wishing Well for their own campaigns/projects using the same process.

### **Staff/Officer roles**

The role of the Peer2Pier Project Facilitator is to support students in the preparation and delivery of their campaign or project and ensure that it is evaluated.

Wishing Well campaigns are **not** officer-led or staff-led, but officers and staff can support and guide the students to help ensure the campaign or project happens.
